Things to think about

- Is your artist's style quite abstract or realistic?
- Think of ways you could follow their style.
- Colour? Does your artist display bright, vibrant, bold colours or softer and calmer? Or even something else?
- Use the colour wheel as a guide to help you mix the colours.
- To produce a higher or darker shade of colour, mix in black or white.



Teachers notes

If pictures were taken on your onsite visit, these can be provided for children to choose from.

Add in extra artists of your choice if you wish to widen the children's choice or follow a particular topic.

Even have a go yourself to inspire the children.
